

Definition of Fees

Fees with asterisk (*) noted after name of fee are subject to return to aid

UC Fees

Tuition*: Formerly known as the Educational Fee, charged to all registered students based on the composition of the program they are attending, provides general support for the University's operating budget, including costs related to general campus and health sciences faculty and instructional support; libraries and other academic support; student services; institutional support; and operation and maintenance of plant. Tuition revenue is also used to provide student financial support.

Student Services Fee*: Formerly known as the Registration Fee, is also charged to all registered students and funds services that are necessary to students but not part of the University's programs of instruction, research, or public service. The majority of the fee funds are spent on student services, including counseling and career guidance, cultural and social activities, and student health services. In addition, some Student Services Fee revenue is used for capital improvements that provide extracurricular benefits for students.

Pre-ILP Tuition and Student Services Fee* : is comprised of Tuition and Student Services per unit fee as set by the Regents of the University of California, multiplied by the Advertised number of units for the program.

ILP Tuition and Student Services Fee*: is comprised of Tuition and Student Services per unit fee as set by the Regents of the University of California, multiplied by the Advertised number of units for the program.

Summer Tuition and Student Services Fee*: is comprised of Tuition and Student Services per unit fee as set by the Regents of the University of California, multiplied by the Advertised number of units for the program.

UCEAP Fees

Program Specific Fee*: fee assessed for a limited number of UCEAP programs that require additional revenues to ensure programmatic and overhead costs are covered by participants. PSF also includes pass thru fees from international partners for program costs and fee.

Participation Fee*: UCEAP Administrative Fee assessed to all student participants to cover overhead expenses, such as health/safety.

Student Activities and Services Fee: May include fees for orientation, excursions, cultural activities, student services support on location

Campus Fees

Campus Based Fees: Assessed on behalf of the student participants' home campus. These fees vary across the UC campuses, by student level, and fund a variety of student-related expenses not supported by other fees. These fees are voted on by the students annually, and help fund programs such as student government, the construction, renovation, and repair of sports and recreational

facilities, and other items such as transit. Campus Based Fees are required by the students' home campus to be assessed during a student participants' time with UCEAP. These fees are returned to the home UC Campus as collected.

Professional School Fee: formerly known as Fees for Selected Professional Students, are paid by students enrolled in a number of professional degree programs to support instruction and specifically to sustain and enhance program quality. The charges vary by program and campus. UCEAP assesses to Professional School fees to UCEAP students as advised by the individual home UC campus and department. These fees are returned to the home UC Campus as collected.

Nonresident Supplemental Tuition : formerly known as Nonresident Tuition, is charged to nonresident students in addition to mandatory charges and any applicable Professional Degree Supplemental Tuition charges, in lieu of State support for the cost of education. Nonresident Supplemental Tuition varies by student level and is required by the students' home campus to be assessed during a student participation with UCEAP. UCEAP assesses Nonresident Supplemental Tuition fees to UCEAP students who are nonresident students as advised by the individual home UC campus. These fees are returned to the home UC Campus as collected.
