



The Spanish Intensive Language program includes many exciting excursions to locations in and around Buenos Aires, including a day long visit to an Estancia in San Antonio de Areco where students have the opportunity to ride horses, eat a traditional Argentine barbecue and relax in the country before officially starting classes.
