Category	Internship Provider	Description
Art	Various local artists	Many opportunities are available to take part in an artist apprenticeship with local artists in Bologna. Duties may include organizing art exhibits, creating installations, cataloguing and organizing works of art, community outreach, grant writing, etc.
Art	Museum of Art	Research on Bolognese artist, Provide tours in English to guests of the Museum, design flyers for the tour, translate informational panels, promote tour to other American study abroad programs in Bologna.
Community Services	Institution devoted to women's culture and political activism	Get insight into feminism, history of women's political movements, gender and women studies, conflict resolution, female migration; Help with the center's daily tasks
Community Services	Association dedicated to raising public awareness about leukemia	Learn the internal operations of a non-profit organization in Italy. Help plan and execute fundraising events, learn how a grassroots organization can contribute to the medical community, educate the public on the research done in the lab. Gain insight into the challenges of funding scientific research and creating structures and support for the well-being of patients.
Culture	New concept bookstore	Observe how this new idea in business, to not sell books but simply take what you want and possibly add to the collection, reflects and affects contemporary society; Help run and promote the store; Work on assigned projects
Culture	Tourism Company	Assist with translations of brochures and websites; Develop ideas for tourist events; Observe the way the Italian community advertises its culture to foreigners
Culture	Museum of History	Work in a museum focusing on the city's history from Etruscan era to present day. Assist in translating informational materials for the museum from Italian to English.
Education	Private Language Schools and Programs	Teach multiple age groups; Develop activities and lesson plans; Be liaison with parents; Work on instructional website and organize school library; Work at summer Camp
Education	Elementary School English Teaching	Teach English to Italian children through song, dance, puppets, and intensive use of important English phrases
Education	Middle School English Teaching	Teach grammar, pronunciation, vocabulary, and phrase mistakes; Prepare lesson plans
Education	Classical High School: English Teaching	Develop structure and content of lesson plans and teach high school students; Examine context of lessons in Italian culture; Teach grammar, pronunciation, vocabulary, and phrase mistakes; Introduce and discuss American culture
Education	Scientific High School: English Teaching	Prepare lesson plans, for example on literary analysis of excerpts from famous texts; Encourage class participation; Use videos

Education	City Tandem Program	Help small groups of Italians practice and perfect their English. Before class, prepare topics for discussion, conversation starters, commonly asked questions. Teach academic English along with colloquialisms.
Health	Medical School	Join doctor on in and out patient rounds; Observe patient consultation and care including pre- and post-operation; Watch general and emergency surgeries both from in and outside the room, *The Faculty member who usually supervises UCEAP students on this internship is no longer with the University of Bologna. If you are interested in an internship with the Medical School you will need to establish contact with the Medical School and see if there is a Faculty member willing to take on interns*
Health	Hospital	Work in Pediatric Ward shadowing doctor; Interact with patients and take measurements; Gain insight in the field of Pediatrics and Genetics; Learn about neurological genetic diseases; Observe doctors in different sectors of the hospital
Health	Rehabilitation Project	Partake in rehabilitation activities of young patients that have come out of a coma; Interact with health professionals and families; Attend informational meetings and seminars with families and volunteers
Media	Foundation for archival conservation and restoration, film and audiovisual promotion and dissemination	Prepare material for the international film festival; Transcribe title cards of silent films and subtitles of foreign films; Convert recorded dialogue into narrative form; Gain knowledge of early silent cinema and talkies, film restoration, and early cinema history
Media	Online network of young adults	Edit, update and improve the English branch of the website; Write articles for the Italian section of the website; Develop own projects to improve website; Attend conferences and meetings
Media	Web Radio of the University of Bologna	Lead one-hour radio show in Italian and English on the cultural differences felt by foreign students in Bologna; Prepare material such as skits, recipes, where to go and not go, foreign guest speaker, explained Italian phrases and/or words
Media	Publishing House	Translate colloquial, academic and technical vocabulary from English to Italian; Translate full-length books for publication; Translate online and internal catalogues of books from Italian to English
Media	Independent Radio Station	Conduct interviews in English and Italian at various cultural events in the city. Translate interview transcripts from English to Italian and vice versa.
Non-Governmental Organization	NGO for Cooperation for the development of emerging countries	Translate work for diverse projects, such as the website and the synopsis of films presented in the Terra di Tutti Film Festival, which features films on immigration, human rights, and environmental protection. Translations include grant proposals, presentations, general reports, meeting minutes, conference scripts in all sectors in which the NGO has been active.

Public Relations	LGBT Archive and Resource Center	Work on exchange of materials with other LGBT centers worldwide; Offer assistance in service, plans, events, and activities; Translate literature, materials, webpages, history; Fall - assist with Gender Bender event; Spring - assist with Gay Pride event
Public Relations	Design management and advertising company	Help with marketing and promotion of new projects; Create communications project/learn about organizational communication - catering to specific clientele and comparative view of Italy vs. the US/California; Translate website in both text and visual media
Public Relations	human rights festival	This is a ten-day event held only in the spring with opportunities to assist pre, during, and post the event. Program compilation, marketing and publicity, quality assurance; Work with the festival's directors, attend press conferences, help with public relations; Small group presentations, social media networks and translations
Public Relations	Non-profit women's organization	Assist the Editor in preparing material for newsletter publications. Responsible for editing article submissions, preparing the layout of the newsletter, and contributing original work.
Public Relations	Cultural projects in the City of Bologna	Promote the Emilia-Romagna region of Italy through the use of technology, marketing, communication, and language. Translate Italian/English, write and proofread journal articles, and promote the culture of Bologna. Help organize the site to be more user-friendly.
Public Relations	Medieval historical monument	Interpret during official tours of the Tower. Translate Italian/English, organize, and maintain the Facebook page. Assist in planning and running other tourist events related to the monument and Bologna in general.
