To apply as an exchange student under the University of California Reciprocal Exchanges, you must be nominated by your home university. Your home university must have an established exchange agreement with the University of California to nominate you.

Some sections of the application must be completed online, while others must be in paper form. Use [How to Apply](#) guidelines to complete the online part of your application. Review the [Preliminary Steps](#) first.

Select your application term, that is the term when you want to begin your exchange at UC. Winter/Spring applicants: Check with your home university international office to ensure applications are being accepted.
