## Chile Spring 2013 Arrival Information

**Print and carry this info with you to Chile. It includes important travel information, including the UCEAP Study Center contacts, which you will need in case of an unexpected delay or emergency.**

### TRAVEL INFO/TIPS

- You are responsible for making all of your travel arrangements to Chile, your transportation from the airport to Campus Oriente, and ensuring that you arrive on time at the specified place and date.
- Check your flight schedule *at least* 24 hrs before departure.
- Arrive at the airport at least 2 ½ hours before departure, to give yourself enough time to get through security.

### CUSTOMS AND IMMIGRATION:

Before landing in Chile, airline staff will give you a form on which you fill out your name, passport number, etc. This paper is stamped by International Police when you enter the country. **Do not discard this form**, even after it has been stamped, and you have entered the country. You will need this form later on in order to complete your Visa process in Santiago.

### DIRECTIONS FROM THE AIRPORT:

The best way to get from the Airport (there is only one international airport) to Campus Oriente is by taxi or by shuttle bus. DO NOT contract any taxi service outside the airport. Instead, ask for a taxi at the airport booth that reads **TAXI OFICIAL AEROPUERTO**. The cost should be about US \$41.00 (~19,000 CLP - Chilean Pesos). The drive takes about 45 minutes. Some students in the past have coordinated with other students on the program to share

taxis. If you want to do this, keep in mind that your luggage will also take up space! Use the [UCEAP Chile Facebook page](#) to meet and coordinate with each other.

Alternatively, Transvip shuttle buses, with a capacity for six (6) people, cost about US \$15.00-20.00 per person for a direct transfer from the airport to Campus Oriente. Make sure you verify and agree on the price before departing.

### **NOTE:**

There is only one entrance gate to the Campus Oriente, so it will be no problem to spot the rest of the UCEAP group and the host families from the parking lot.

### **EARLY ARRIVAL:**

If you arrive on the early morning flight on January 23, it is OK to go to Campus Oriente early.

Students who arrive in Santiago before January 23 are responsible for arranging their own accommodations. Past students have stayed on these hostels:
