

For UCEAP Students Taking Dependents or Traveling Companions Abroad

Instructions and Required Form

A “dependent” includes a spouse, registered domestic partner (same sex), and/or child.

A “traveling companion” may be a friend or family member accompanying you for the duration of the program.

If you are planning to take a dependent or traveling companion abroad, do the following immediately:

1. Notify your Campus EAP Advisor.
2. Review the [list of UCEAP programs](#) with restrictions on taking dependents.
3. Read the “Students with Dependents” section of the [UCEAP Guide to Study Abroad](#).
4. Complete and return the required [Memorandum of Understanding](#) to UCEAP.
 - If a dependent (as defined in first sentence above) will accompany you on UCEAP, read item #4 in the *Memorandum* carefully. It explains the insurance coverage options for your dependent(s) and gives you directions for the online payment and registration.
