

## UCEAP Health Clearance Instructions

All students are required to submit a completed UCEAP Health Clearance form.

The health clearance process can take several weeks. Do not delay in getting started.

The UCEAP health clearance process varies by campus. See the links below for your campus-specific information. If you have further questions regarding the process, contact your Campus EAP Office or Student Health Services.

It is your responsibility to initiate the health clearance process, monitor the completion of the health clearance, and submit the UCEAP Health Clearance form to the [UCEAP Systemwide Office](#) by the designated deadline. Do not expect or assume that the health practitioner or your campus Student Health Services office will submit the form to UCEAP on your behalf.
