These are the **minimum amounts** needed for the host UC campus to issue a certificate of eligibility (DS-2019 or I-20) for **visa application**. It is important to remember that these amounts are estimates. Actual expenses may vary depending on the student's lifestyle and extra activities. The cost of travel is not included in these estimates.

Students should document the highest amount for their campus choices. If possible, we also recommend that students document funds allowing for a ten to fifteen percent increase in the figures provided since **amounts are subject to reevaluation and may change** prior to issue of the certificate of eligibility.
